AGREEMENT made this 7th day of NOVEMBER, 1947, between
HOLLYWOOD PRODUCTIONS, INC., and SHIRLEY ^{Seiler} ~~Lowman~~
(Employer) (Artist)

1. The EMPLOYER hereby engages the ARTIST to render exclusive services at the Earl Carroll Theatre-Restaurant in Hollywood, California, for a period of TWO (2) weeks commencing on or about NOVEMBER 11,, 1947, or within one week thereafter, at a salary of *** FIFTY ** Dollars (\$50.00) per week, or pro rata thereof, for not less than six (6) days

2. The ARTIST shall report for rehearsal at the Earl Carroll Theatre-Restaurant in Hollywood, California, not later than FOURTEEN, 1947.

3. The EMPLOYER has the privilege of executing an option to extend this agreement for a further period of two (2) weeks, said option to be picked up in writing to the ARTIST one week prior to the expiration of this agreement and the EMPLOYER may continue executing said two (2) week options for a period not to exceed thirty (30) weeks.

4. The EMPLOYER shall give at least one week's notice in writing to the ARTIST in the event of the termination of the production, and the ARTIST agrees not to appear professionally in the county of Los Angeles, or within a radius of two hundred miles, from the time of signing this agreement until the termination of this engagement.

5. Fourteen (14) performances shall constitute a week, but in no event shall exceed two complete performances daily except as herein otherwise provided. Extra performances shall be paid for pro rata.

6. The term "ARTIST" means all actors, singers, dancers and other performers in the variety field, including principals, chorus and persons engaged in specialty acts, and the ARTIST hereby warrants that he or she is a member of AGVA in good standing and will remain so for the duration of this agreement and the ARTIST and EMPLOYER hereby agree that there is incorporated into this agreement and made a part hereof all the provisions of the Minimum Basic Agreement entered into between the EMPLOYER herein and AGVA dated December 19, 1946, and that each and all of the terms thereof shall govern the employment of the ARTIST, and the EMPLOYER further agrees that no ARTIST shall receive less than the minimum salary stated in this Basic Agreement.
